### PROCEEDINGS

The conference proceedings will be in English. A CD-ROM with the proceedings of each day, as well as white papers, poster papers and reference documents will be published in English and will be made available to all the registered delegates. The cost of these CD-ROMs is included in the delegate registration fee. The CDs will be airmailed out the week after the conference. These CD-ROMs can also be ordered by non-delegates.
